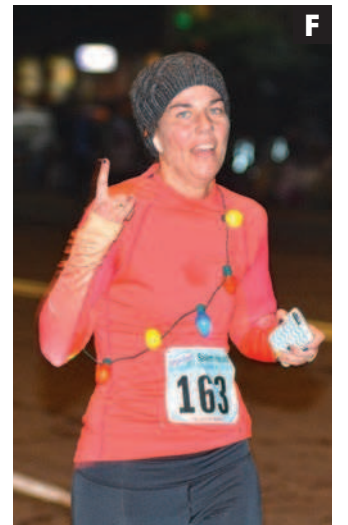


Feelin' Festive
