

Celtics fall in final dual meet of the season

In their last tune-up before the district tournament, the McNary wrestling team fell 40-30 to McKay in their final dual meet of the season.

Even though it didn't show on the scoreboard, Celtic wrestlers were competitive in every single match through the lineup.

"We got what we wanted because our kids were in every match," McNary head coach Jason Ebbs said. "We competed with desire and heart and we were in a spot to win."

McKay's Israel Rivas won

the opening match of the night in the 220-pound bout with a 9-3 decision against Aldo Villalvazo. But the Royal Scots had to forfeit the next two matches, allowing McNary to go on top 12-3.

It looked like the Celtics were going to extend their advantage in the 113-pound match as Grady Burrows had a 4-2 lead after the first round and appeared to gain the upper hand. But the McNary sophomore got spun around on his back and couldn't avoid the second round fall.

However, Noah Gatchet (120 lbs) got McNary's first victory on the mat as he

pinned his opponent 90 seconds into the bout.

After losing the 126-pound match, McNary got their second win from Estaban Victoria (132 lbs.) who battled hard for a 7-3 decision to give the Celtics a 21-15 lead after seven bouts.

Gilbert Parra (138 lbs.) followed with an impressive win of his own.

With the match tied 2-2 late in the second round, Parra got the edge after scoring on a two-point reversal as the buzzer sounded.

The junior got some insurance points with a take-down in the third round and

came away with the 6-2 win.

But losses from Ryan Bamford and Matthew Melhloff — as well as a pair of McNary forfeits — was too much for the Celtics to overcome.

However, McNary did end the meet on a high note.

Garrett Wampler (195 lbs.) is the only four-year varsity wrestler on the McNary squad this season, and in his last home match of his career, Wampler earned a pin in the second round.

"I worked so hard for the last four years, so to close it out like that really meant a lot," Wampler said. "This pro-

gram has developed me into the guy I am today."

Wampler went up 2-0 in the first round after a take-down, then scored two more points early in the second round on a reversal before pinning Gerald Jennings with 1:20 remaining.

"Garrett has given everything to he has for this program," Ebbs said. "I can't ever replace the loyalty of a four-year wrestler."

With it being his fourth year in the program, Wampler has taken pride in his leadership role for this young McNary team.

"I'm glad that I could be a

leader for the underclassmen this year and help get them to where they needed to be because that was what I had when I was a freshman and sophomore," Wampler said.

McNary will compete in the Mountain Valley Conference District Tournament this weekend (Friday and Saturday) at Sprague High School — the Celtics are expected to have 27 athletes competing, which is among the highest in the league.

"The more guys in the tournament competing and engaged means that we're continuing to grow," Ebbs said.
