Handley encouraged the students to live their lives by leaning into four key principles: embracing adversity, honoring loved ones, celebrating other’s successes and carrying a growth mindset.

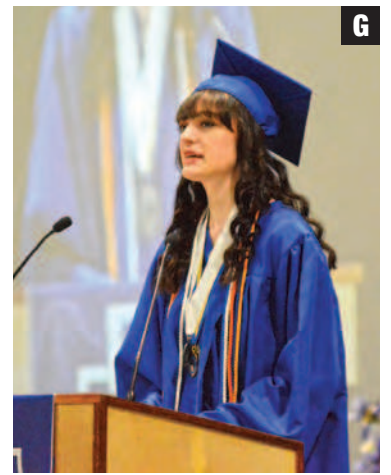
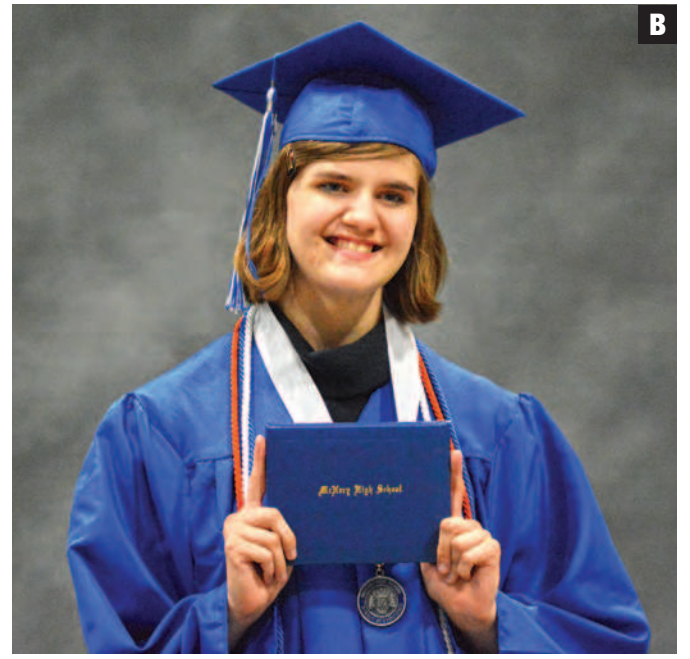
