

Williams shines at WOU

Former McNary standout Jonathan Williams wrapped up a stellar freshman season for the Western Oregon University Lacrosse team over the spring.

With 59 goals and 10 assists, Williams led the Wolves in scoring and was a first-team all-Collegiate Lacrosse Association performer and was also recognized as a third-team All-American midfielder as he helped the Wolves to a 9-4 record.

Williams scored a goal in all 12 games he appeared in this season.

His best performance came in a 20-10 victory against Cal State San Marcos where he scored eight goals and had three assists. Williams also had seven goals and two assists in a 24-3 win over Pacific Lutheran.

Williams is currently pursuing a degree in exercise science.

Ricardo Genoves doubled Franklin Labour home in the sixth for the final run of the game for Salem-Keizer.

Kervin Castro started for the Volcanoes and became the losing pitcher at 1-1 but came out with a 2.70 earned run average. Jesse Stinnett

was the winning pitcher in relief with a 2-0 record and a 1.13 ERA.

Sunday, June 30: Volcanoes 11, Boise 9

The Volcanoes avoided a sweep with this victory over the hard-fighting Boise Hawks.

Boise had a 3-0 lead going into the fourth inning when Salem-Keizer went ahead with a four-run fifth. Six more Volcano runs came in the sixth and one more in the eighth, but the Hawks added three in the eighth and two in the ninth.

Ricardo Genoves had three hits for the Volcanoes, including his first triple. Sean Roby, Yorlis Rodriguez, and Kwan Adkins had two each. Simon Whiteman hit a three-run double in the fifth.

Tyler Schimpf was the winning pitcher in relief of starter Jacob Lopez, with a 1-0 record. Bryce Tucker got his second save. Rayne Supple, also in relief, took the loss (0-1).

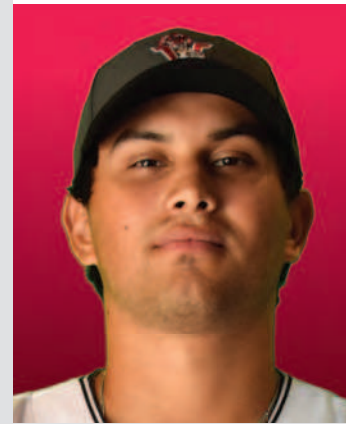
