Sprague scored eight of the first nine points to being the fourth set and later took a commanding 17-5 lead. The Celtics, however, were able to make the score a little more respectable in the end, thanks to strength of their blocking attack.

"When our blockers are in-sync, it does a lot for our chemistry, and we definitely saw that in bits and pieces tonight," DeMello said.
