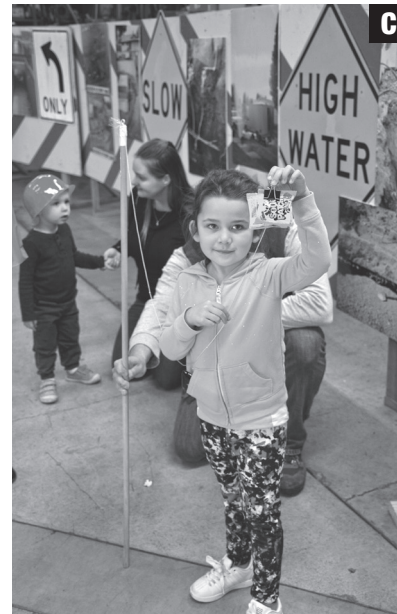

Allison Boxall, owner of Summit Design Interiors in Keizer, won the 2019 Structure+Style Award for interior design from *Oregon Home Magazine*.

Up against some of the largest design firms in Oregon, Boxall won for her design renovation of a home in West Salem.

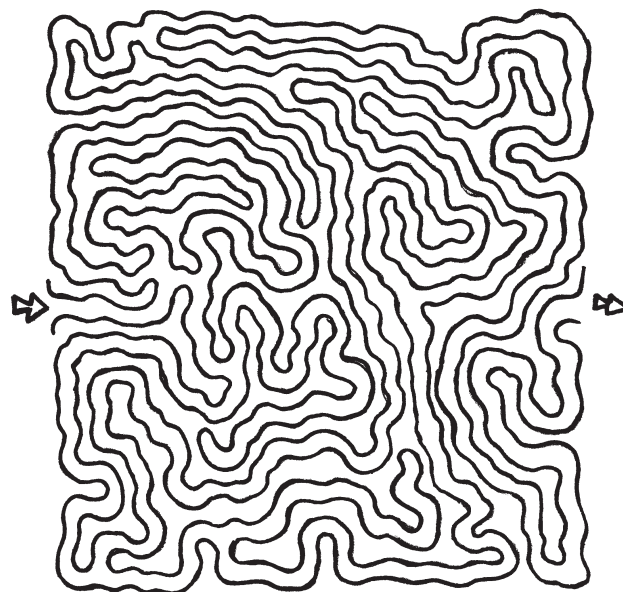
