The patterns in the book were designed for 8.5x11 paper (standard printer paper) If you're using paper larger or smaller, you may need to adjust the designs accordingly.

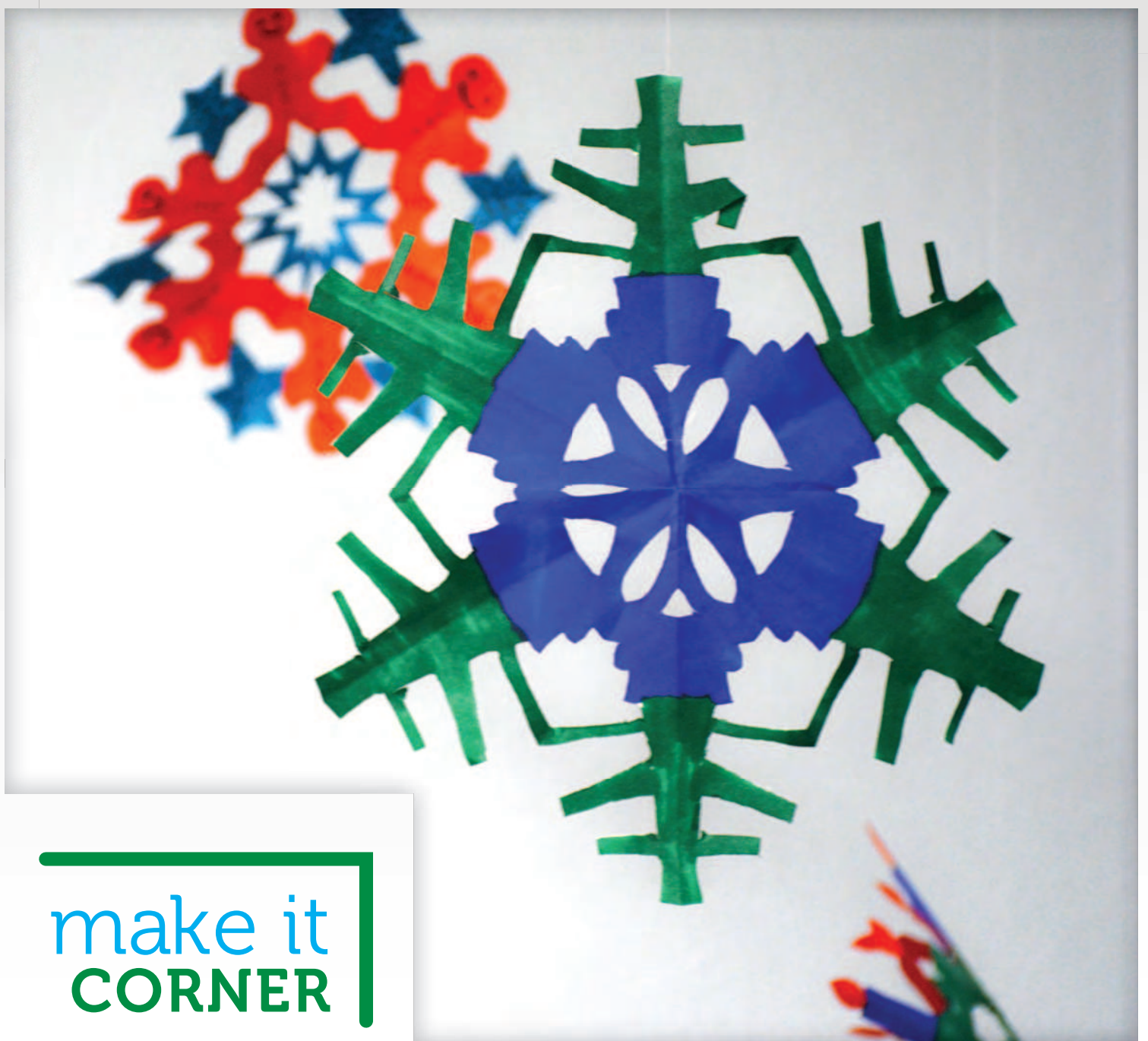
First you need to turn your paper into a square. Take the top left corner and fold it down until the edge is flat.

Your paper should be a triangle with an extra rectangle hanging off the side.

Cut the rectangle off.

Fold the triangle in half to make a smaller triangle.

Fold that triangle into thirds (if it's not even that's

okay, it'll add character).

Cut a straight line across the front of your triangle (you may need to unfold it, that's okay)

Now we can start doing the fun stuff. Trace the design

on the triangle below onto the front of your triangle (you may need to unfold it, that's okay)

Cut the lines out, carefully. You may need to ask an adult

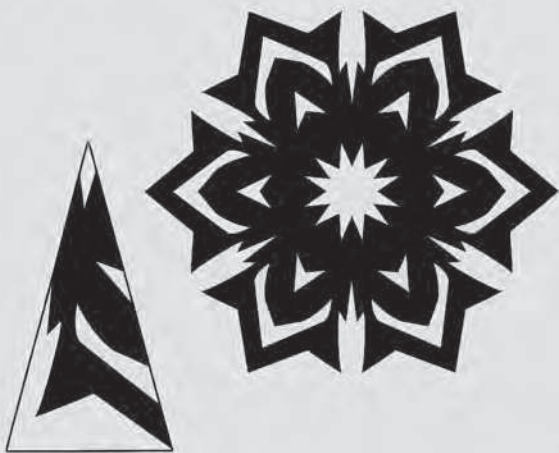
to come help you – they can look this time, we'll allow it.

When you're done cutting, unfold it to reveal your design. You can color it if you'd like or leave it white.

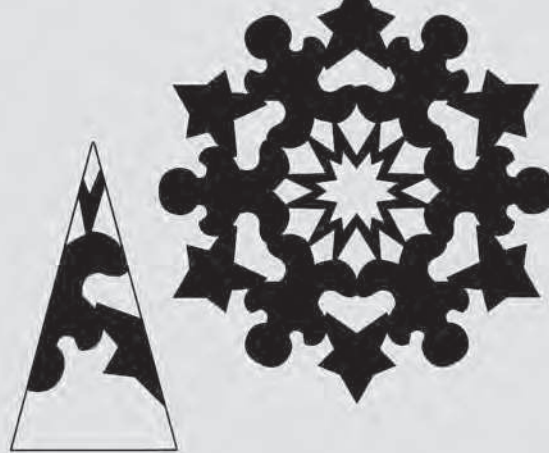
Finally, don't forget to hang it up in the window.
