said Howald. "These were and continue to be unusual times and we want to add them to the historical record of the city."

Depending on response, future interview dates may be scheduled. Those with longer stories may be asked to return and finish their interviews at a later date.

Becker and Howald decided independently that they wanted to do more to document Keizer's response to the pandemic and found each other when Howald inquired about archiving interviews at the museum.

The pair plan to use the stories in a variety of ways. Becker plans to edit the video into a compilation telling the story of Keizer's pandemic response. Howald plans to use interviews in the Keizertimes and to produce an audio documentary that could be aired on KMUZ community radio at a later date.

Participants are welcome to participate in small, family groupings. Volunteers will meet participants at the door of the Keizer Cultural Center and guide them through the next steps.

Volunteers needed to fill city advisory committees

The City of Keizer is looking for volunteers to serve on the following committees and commissions:

- Budget Committee – Responsibilities include assisting the City Council in the examination and analyzing of proposed budgets for Keizer. Applicants must be registered voters in Keizer.
- The committee meets in May of each year to review the annual budget (three vacancies).
- Keizer Planning Com-

mission – Help the city make decisions regarding land use, growth, development and beautification. There are state-mandated guidelines for the composition and organization of this group and members are required to file a disclosure of economic interests (two vacancies).

- Keizer Points of Interest – meets the fourth Thursday of each month at 6 p.m. to identify and memorialize points of interest (one vacancy).
- Youth liaison and pages –

teens can apply to be youth voices on many of the city's committees. Meeting times depend on assignment.

DELIGHT: City plans to monitor parking when schools reopen

(Continued from Page A1) he was in contact with neighbors along the route regarding parking and that if problems develop the city could take action to make it a no parking zone.

When Fisher posted about her issues with the area on social media, she said Mayor Cathy Clark responded that the path was never intended for bikes, only pedestrians. Parking is permitted on a multiuse path, but not a bike path. The path is not striped or otherwise signaled as a bike path.

Fisher said the final design fell short no matter what the city chose to call it. "If it's a path it's not designed

and built as a path, if it's a walkway it's not designed and built as a walkway," she said. "I'm not sure how it is going to function when schools open up and not sure families will let kids walk there."

She added there are extra elements of danger for pedestrians, such as cars pulling out of driveways, without more being done to signal the path's intended use.

"There are ways to re-stripe it or identify that it is not a place for parking, but those visual cues are not there currently," Fisher said. "I feel bad for the neighborhood and that they have not received something that we said was coming."

Federal, state taxes due July 15

The Oregon Department of Revenue is reminding taxpayers that July 15 is the deadline for filing a tax return and paying taxes due. Oregon extended the deadline when the IRS extended the deadline to file and pay federal taxes due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

For personal income taxpayers:

- The Oregon return filing due date for tax year 2019 is July 15, 2020.

• The Oregon tax payment deadline for payments due with the 2019 tax year is July 15, 2020.

• The tax year 2019 six-month extension to file until October 15, 2020, if requested, extends only to the filing (not payment) deadline.

If you have questions about your personal income tax, contact questions.dor@oregon.gov.

For corporate income/excise taxpayers:

• The Oregon return filing due date for tax year 2019 is July 15, 2020.

• The Oregon tax payment deadline for payments for the

2019 return, normally May 15, 2020, is now July 15, 2020.

• Fiscal year returns and related payments due after July 15, 2020 are not extended at this time.

Interest and penalties:

• Because of the extension of the due dates for filing returns and making payments, any interest and penalties with respect to Oregon tax filings and payments begin accruing on July 16, 2020.

• No automatic extension is provided for the payment or deposit of any other type of Oregon tax or for the filing of Oregon information returns.

that reduce violence and harassment. Eliminating this section from the charter is an opportunity to put a protective factor in place, and signal to our youth and residents that they are accepted and can live and thrive in this community."

Other recommendations include reordering some sections of the charter for clarity and making it easier to read and understand. While some larger changes were discussed, such as switching to electing city councilors by district or ranked-choice voting, not enough members of the task force voted to

move forward on those matters. Despite not making the cut, residents are welcome to talk with the council about support or opposition to such changes during the public hearings as the council has the final say.

The council is likely to debate their own stances on the changes after public testimony and vote to approve or reject sending the matter to voters. Upon approval by the city council, the changes to the charter will be turned into a ballot measure that will appear on the November ballot. Voters must approve all changes to the charter.
