The Oregon chapter of the American Cancer Society will light up the steps of the Oregon Capitol building Saturday, Sept. 12.

At 7 p.m., Lights of Hope bags will be used to illuminate the word "hope" on the steps of the building, a tribute to cancer patients, survivors and advocates. Martin (Marty) Giovannini left the world suddenly on August 27, 2020—and left behind an indelible impression with infinite ripples.

Born in Santa Rosa, California, Marty was the eldest of five. His gentle and generous spirit made him a natural caretaker. From his professional roles as a teacher, mediator, and volunteer to his instinctive roles as a father, son, brother, husband, lover and best friend, Marty looked out for others at every turn. "There is nothing more meaningful than a respect for, dedication to, and love of family," he said in one of his renowned toasts.

After graduating from Montgomery High School in 1967, Marty earned a Master of Arts degree from Sonoma State University in counseling. That focus and the plan to raise a family, brought him to Oregon in 1981 where he went on to help pioneer the practice of open adoption. He treasured his role as a perpetual student and never ceased in his quest for knowledge about the earthly and celestial. He parlayed his learned and innate talents into being a published author and poet and an award-winning fine art photographer. As an adjunct professor at Chemeketa Community College, he taught black-and-white film photography for more than 20 years.
