McNary can't complete comeback vs. West Salem

After trailing by double-digits for most of the second half, the McNary football team was able to come back to make it a one possession game midway through the fourth quarter, but a pair of key first down runs late in the period from West Salem allowed the Titans to run out the clock as McNary fell to their conference foe by a score of 28-20. McNary head coach Jeff Auvinen said that he would like his team to show more consistency but was glad to see much higher effort and energy in this game after a poor performance in their previous game against Sprague.

"A little more consistency would be nice, but I was glad that we brought the energy this week. We weren't perfect, but it was nice to get a couple of turnovers," Auvinen said. "As long as we are playing with energy and giving everything we have, we are going to compete."

The Celtics struggled in the opening period for the second straight week as West Salem took advantage of a McNary

turnover on their first possession and converted it into points as Jackson Lowery connected with John Kenny on a 27-yard fade for the score, giving the Titans the early lead.
