Richard truly loved his wife, and was devoted to his family, coaching and being involved with the American Legion.

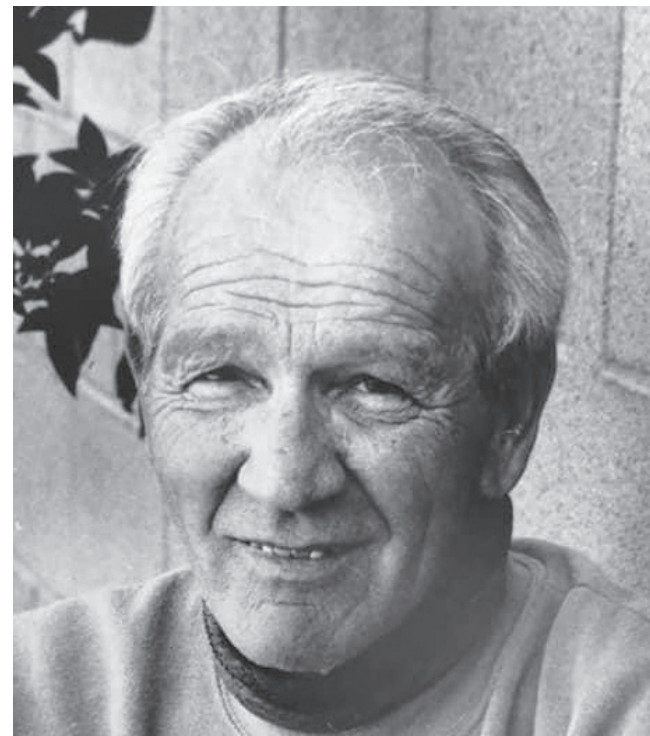
He was preceded in death by his parents, sisters Gloria and Deborah, son Mark.
