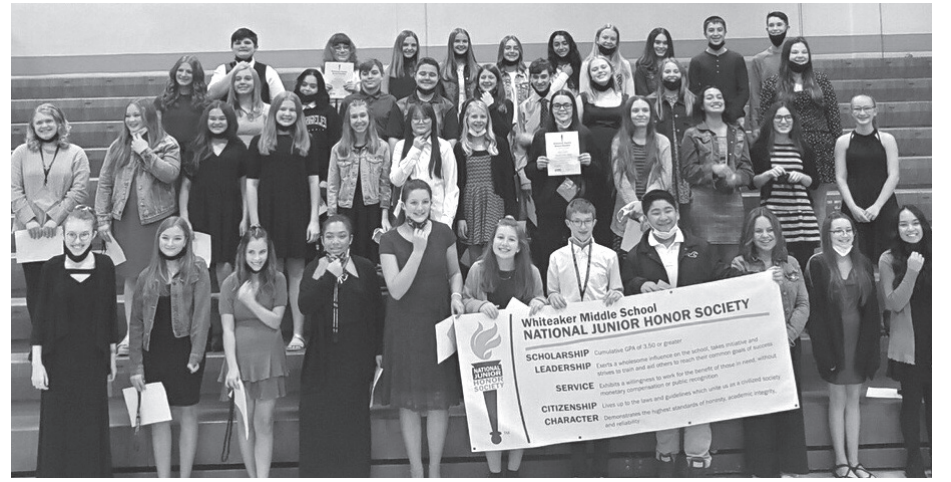
Cohen added, "Our goal with this worldwide event is for organizations to provide hope, inspiration and excitement to their communities through the power of musical theatre."
