Salem-Keizer school board approves proclamation honoring parents and guardians

The Salem-Keizer school board joined with district parents at the Jan. 11 board meeting to adopt a proclamation making January the Parent and Guardian Engagement in Education

Parents and school board members had worked together for weeks to shape the January proclamation, which stated that while November is typically National Parent Engagement Month, "the New Year provides us an opportunity to celebrate and honor our parents and guardians."

The proclamation was unanimously approved by the seven person board after a short discussion.

Multiple public speakers implored the school board superintendent Christy Perry not to close schools as COVID cases soar in Oregon and to reverse mask and vaccine mandates.

Masks requirements in schools and vaccine requirements for educators came from the State of Oregon and Gov. Kate Brown, not Salem-Keizer School District leadership.
