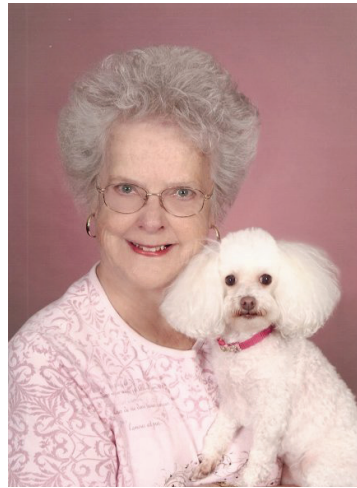
Kathryn Taylor

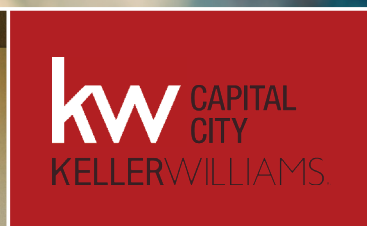
