Agencies Appropriation bill that French Senegalese troops rounded up the German women in a subway in Stuttgart, held them there for several days and raped them.

"All American liaison officers with the French Army Corps and lower units which have been in or near Stuttgart at any time have submitted written reports to this headquarters," the statement said, "that to their knowledge and belief incidents such as alleged did not take place."

our race, insulted Negro soldiers by calling them cowards and denounced all persons and organizations who called for fair play for minority groups.

In a recent issue of "The Voice", of New York in the Editorial Column was the following article:

## Eastland's Stuttgart Lie

"In his desperate effort to rape FEPC through vicious slanders against the Negro people, Mississippi's Senator Eastland, just returned from a trip to Europe, told a sensational tale about the alleged mass raping of 5,000 German women by Senegalese (French colonial) troops in a Stuttgart subway. His story was promptly repudiated by the French government and by Allied military chiefs in the area. Now it develops that Stuttgart doesn't even have a subway.

"Eastland's grotesque lie is worthy of Hitler. It reflects the depths of depravity to which many polltaxers from the Deep South have sunk. And it should be a warning to America that if our democracy is to live and grow, we must utterly destroy those rotten, feudalistic regimes which spew forth the Eastlands and Bilbos and Rankins to pollute the pollute the political life of our nation."

People reading such utterances as made by H. R. Emerick, Bilbo and Eastland should consider the source from whence it came.

Emerick is really pitiful; he states: "One of the Negro's best known traits is that he is continually complaining."

It is known by even an idiot that on the contrary, the Negro has been known as the most patient of all groups. From the time that he was brought to this country in the

arly 16th century he bore his suffering with great fortitude. He is known to sing, smile and pray in the field, at home, on the streets—anywhere. He has become accustomed to abuses and insults and bears up under them admirably.

Emerick cannot differentiate between "fighting for your rights" and complaining.
