### NEIGHBORHOOD WRECKED

"This is no ordinary case," declared White. "A firsthand look at the situation reveals even more outrageous handling than was indicated in newspaper stories. The killing of two prisoners in the jail and the wounding of another indicates what the Negro citizens of the small community of Columbia are up against.

"Unless they receive outside aid, unless the country is aroused to condemn this kind of thing that took place in Columbia, Negro citizens of small communities throughout the nation will be helpless.'
