

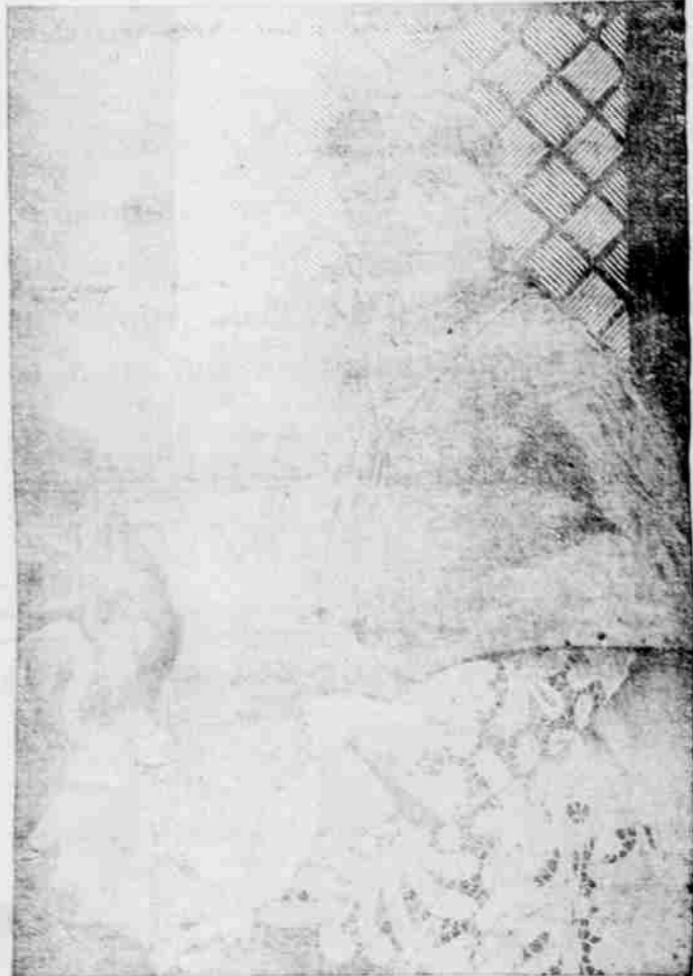
# MAN'S LIFE A MEANS TO AN END

**FIRST DAY.**  
Half mile dash, for saddle horses owned in Crook county, for a Purse of \$75.00  
Half mile and repeat, free for all for a purse of \$150.00  
**SECOND DAY.**  
Three eights of a mile dash, free for all for a purse of \$100.00  
Half mile and repeat handicap race, free for all. Purse \$125.00  
Half mile dash for two year olds for a purse of \$75.00  
**THIRD DAY.**  
Three quarter of a mile dash, free for all for a purse of \$200.00  
Novelty race; walk 1/2 mile, trot 1/2 mile, run 1/2 mile; for Crook county horses only. Purse \$75.00  
**FOURTH DAY.**  
Three mile Indian horse race. No entrance fee. Not less than eight start. Purse \$40.00  
**FIFTH DAY.**  
Consolation race, five-eighths of a mile for a purse of \$100.00
