


## MAN'S LIFE A MEANS TO AN END

Three eights of a mile dash, free for all for a purse of \$100.00

Half mile and repeat handicap race, free for all. purse \$125.00

Half mile dash for two year olds for a purse of \$75.00

Three quarter of a mile dash, free

for all for a purse of \$200.00

Novelty race; walk  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, trot  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile, run  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile; for Crook county horses only. Purse \$75.00

FOURTH DAY.

Three mile Indian horse race. No entrance fee. Not less than eight o' start. Purse \$40.00
