

**County Court Proceedings**

The September term of the County Court convened Wednesday, September 4, 1901. The full board being present, and the following proceedings were had:

In the matter of the sheriff's return for lands sold July 8, 1901. Sale confirmed.

In the matter of petition of D W Barnett, et al, for road, the petition was refused for reason that same is defective as to proof of notice and in not giving a definite starting point.

In the matter of the petition of F Forget, et al, for county road, the report of viewers read first and second times and no remonstrance or bill for damage being offered the matter of causing the same to be platted and ordered opened was taken under advisement until the first day of the next regular term.

In the matter of the following wrongful assessments the sheriff was ordered credited with the following amounts on the roll of 1900:

In the matters of the tax rolls of 1896, 1897, 1898, 1899 and 1900, the clerk was ordered to attach warrant returnable in 60 days from the 6th day of Sept., 1901.

In the matter of the tax roll for 1901, same examined and accepted.

In the matter of bids for the construction of the Newsom creek bridge, the surveyor being present, bids were opened on the first of session and taken under consideration. Bid of C L Shattuck, \$500; bid of J B Shipp, \$397.

In the matter of the Robinson road. Ordered that Jas Robinson is authorized to enter into contract with any responsible person to grade and open up that part of said road lying south of the Derham mill and to authorize the expenditure not to exceed \$50.

The county judge having exhibited receipts from L H Hamilton for the sum of \$148.76 paid out for labor performed on the Robinson road, leaving a balance in his hands of \$1.27.

In the matter of tax sales, it appearing upon a careful examination of the records that the following named tax certificates issued upon sales of lands for delinquent taxes, have been illegally issued. It is ordered that the same be and they are hereby declared void and the same be cancelled, to wit: Certificates issued in 1897, Nos. 61, 71, 130, 82, 86, 66, 104, 116 and 117; certificate No. 57 issued in 1896; certificates Nos. 147, 141, 142, 152, 154, 157, 161, 162, 185, 166, 168, 169, 170, 175, 177, 179, 180, 181, 182, 183, 185, 187, 189, 190, 191, 194, 200, 201, 134, 193.

In the matter of wrongful sale of land of John Arnold: Ordered that clerk draw warrant in favor of John Arnold in the sum of \$6.42, being principal and 5 per cent interest from July 8, 1901.

In the matter of the construction of the Newsom creek bridge. Ordered that the bid of J B Shipp be accepted to construct said bridge according to the plans and specifications submitted to the court by the surveyor, and further ordered that J B Shipp be required to furnish a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$1000, to be approved by the court. J H Healy objects to the letting of the contract at this term, but desires that the legality of the transaction be submitted to the district attorney, and be continued until the first day of the next regular term.

In the matter of repairs on the Agency road in district No. 8, it was ordered that the supervisor of said district be authorized to expend a sum equal to \$50, and no more, upon said road between this date and the first day of the next regular term. It was further ordered that the clerk notify said supervisor of this order.

In the matter of repayment of money to A C Palmer on illegal sale of land described in certificate No. 102 ordered that warrant be drawn for \$3.35 in favor of A. C. Palmer.
