Was a Noble Man.

The news of the death of Rev. H. K. Hines at his home near Portland last Sunday morning, brought sorrow to the people of the entire northwest, for certainly there was no man on the coast who was more generally known and loved. He was a noble character of man, one made after the image of the Creator, one whose entire life was spent for the betterment of mankind.

Mr. Hines was a pioneer of Oregon, and was one of the main factors in bringing order out of chaos in the early days of the state. To the people of this vicinity he was ever a kind friend and welcome visitor. In 1854 he assisted in organizing a Methodist church here, and was for many years its pastor. Later he was presiding elder of the district that extended into Idaho and as far south as the California line. Some time in the early '80s he removed to Portland to assume editorial management of the Pacific Christian Advocate, which position he filled for many years. He had lived a well-spent life, and his memory will long be cherished by all those who knew him.—Dalles Mountaineer.

Fought at Waterloo.

Leonard Roeder, of Quincy, Illinois, celebrated his 102 birthday Tuesday. He is one of the very few persons left in the world who witnessed the conflict on the plain of Waterloo, which changed the map of Europe and humbled the pride of the "Little Corporal." That will be 87 years ago on the 15th of next June, but the events are still fresh in the mind of this centenarian. He was there as a member of General Blucher's army, and has his discharge papers. It is now 58 years since he came to this country from Germany. A few years ago he lost control of the English language, which he spoke fluently, and now can converse only in German.

His hair is white as snow, but otherwise Mr. Roeder exhibits no special mark of his extreme age:

A Big Irrigation Scheme.

PEPPLTON, OR., Jan. 24.—The Oregon Land & Water Company, of which F. B. Holcomb is manager, has bought 27,000 acres of arid land from C. B. Wade, cashier of the First National Bank of Pendleton, which it proposes to place under water, and people with colonists from Fresno, Cal., as well as from other localities, where men can be found who are experts in the raising of fruits and vegetables. The company already owns a large area of land, together with a ditch just below Umatilla, lying partly in this county, and partly in Morrow. The ditch and contiguous lands were bought last year from the company formed by D. W. Bailey, and representing the outlay of much money. At this time the ditch is being repaired and placed in condition to put a large area of land under water. Under the former management the ditch was operated sufficiently to demonstrate that the land will raise almost anything produced in this zone.

The company offers no land for sale, intending to carry on a business of its own, and to engage in the breeding of livestock, as well as the raising of garden and orchard products. A large portion of the 27,000 acre tract will be fit for pasture when it has been somewhat restored to the condition in which it was before the bunchgrass was eaten off by stock. The experiments of the company will be of value in another manner, by proving whether the thousands of acres of land once rich in bunch grass, but now almost barren of vegetation, may be restored.
