Call for the Republican Primaries and County Convention.

The Republican County Convention for Crook county is hereby called to meet in Prineville, at the court house, on March 24th, 1902, at 10 o'clock a. m., for the purpose of nominating officers for the coming state election, and also to elect delegates to the state and congressional conventions, and to do such other business as may be brought before the convention.

Being one delegate at large for each precinct and one delegate for each 16 votes or major fraction of 9 or over as cast for the Hon. J. N. Williamson for State Senator in 1900.

It is recommended that the primaries be held on March 15th, 1902, at 1 o'clock p. m., in each precinct for the election of such delegates.

Also further recommended that all persons holding proxies shall be a resident and voter in the precinct for which he holds such proxies.

Big Bend Electric Railway.

SPOKANE, Feb. 28.—I. E. Moses, of Seattle, met the farmers of the Big Bend country at Waterville this afternoon and discussed contracts for an electric railway extending from the Great Northern Road at Rock Island and about 80 miles north and east of Waterville and Buckingham. Power is to be taken from Chelan Falls. The proposed contracts call for the building of 30 miles of road within one year and completing the entire road by December, 1905. The road would handle both freight and passengers. Farmers within 10 miles of the line are asked for a bonus ranging from \$5 to \$50 per quarter section. The promoters refused to tell who is expected to provide the capital.

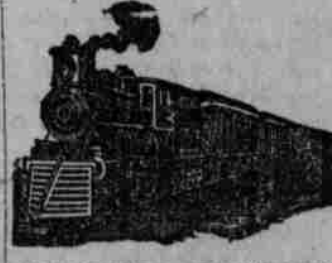
