

To Drown Gambling.

In view of the fact that Section 1968 of the criminal code and Section 3526 relating to unlawful gaming makes it a misdemeanor to carry on any gambling game whether played for money, checks or credits or any representative of value, and the offender upon conviction may be fined in a sum not more than \$500 and shall be imprisoned until the fine be paid.

Also that Section 3552 makes it the especial duty of each district attorney, sheriff, constable, city or town marshal to inform against and diligently prosecute any and all persons whom they shall have reasonable cause to believe guilty of a violation of the provisions of this act.

Section 3533 also provides that any such officer who shall refuse or willfully neglect to inform against and prosecute offenders against this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

In view of these facts I would suggest that some such petition as the following be submitted to the citizens of The Dalles and presented to the proper officials:

We, the undersigned citizens of The Dalles, Or., fearless of the consequence by way of respite demand the discontinuance of slot machines and gambling in the city. The future citizenship of the youth of our land cannot by our silent approval be thus further demoralized and we pledge our united efforts to the elevation of the manhood of the coming generations.
