GIVE ORDERS FOR BUILDING

Oregon Trunk Line Making Ready to Commence Work

Orders for the materials and the immediate erection of a tool house and a bunk house at Sherar's bridge, on the Deschutes river, have been placed by W. F. Nelson, of the Oregon Trunk Line, and the announcement is made that grading will commence at once at that point on the right-of-way. It has already been announced that grading would begin at the mouth of the Deschutes by the 10th of May, and from the preparations being made at Sherar's bridge, it may be assumed that several grading crews will be put to work along the proposed line, in order to hasten the work.

Will Irrigate 2000 Acres of Land

The White Rock Irrigation & Power Co. will not install a pumping plant, as contemplated, but will at once begin the construction of a ditch somewhat smaller than was at first anticipated. The original plans of the company were to build a ditch that would carry water sufficient to irrigate some 3000 acres, but as about one-third of this can be better irrigated by means of a pumping plant situated at Cline Falls, the power and land being owned by the same parties, it has been decided to install more machinery there. This will reduce the land to be reclaimed by ditch to 2000 acres. The board of directors have been ordered to secure right of way and receive bids on the ditch in parcels, thus allowing a part of the stockholders to build by contract, small parts of the ditch. Construction work will be begun as soon as possible, and when completed, the company will have a ditch, as nearly as could be estimated at their meeting held in Cline Falls on last Monday, approximately 12 miles in length, including three and one-half miles of flume, which will be four feet deep. The entire work will cost \$15,000, will consume from two to four months in construction and will carry about 1500 to 2000 miners inches of water. The flume will be built through a very rough canyon and will be constructed of surfaced lumber.
