through the crevices in the rock in the roof of the tunnel water came out drop by drop; through the same crevices came also roots of plants; these were found to be alfalfa roots, which came down from an old field of the plant over the tunnel through a depth of soil and rock of 120 feet."

This unusual penetrating power is of the greatest agricultural importance. The alfalfa thereby not only obtains its food from far below the root range of ordinary crops, thus leaving the surface FOR SALE .- 1520 acres of good land, store for shallower feeders, but when these deep-boring roots die and decay they leave not only their own fertilizing properties, but innumerable openings for air and moisture and humus from the surface to penetrate. This, at first thought, might not appear of much importance, but in a well set alfalfa field five years old, five feet below the surface there would be from 10 to 30 roots to each square foot, averaging an eight of an inchin diameter, reaching directly from the surface. With this fact known. the value of alfalfa as both a subsoiler and fertilizer is more easily appreciated.
