





the fact of the efficiency of such institution shall be determined by the school board after an examination of such child, or children, by the eight grade examining board of the county.

### PENALTY

In case any parent or other person in parental relation shall not comply with the provisions of this act he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, on conviction thereof, be liable to a fine viction thereof, be liable to a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$25, or by imprisonment in the country or city jail not less than both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.
