Wasnington, D. c., February 21, 1908. Registers and Recivers, United States Land Offices.-Gentlemen: In cases of applications to locate all script, warrants, certificates, soldier's additional homestead rights, or to make lieu selections of public lands of the United States, the following requirements will govern on and after April 1, 1908:

1. The location or selection must be accompanied, in addition to the evidence required by existing rules and regulations, by affidavit of the locator, selector, or some credible person possessed of the requisite personal knowledge of the premises, showing that the, R.
