In the vicinity where the writer lives representatives of a foreign grocery house canvassed for supplies, and a bill of goods which one of their customers bought, which was later put on exhibition, contained several eye openers. One of these was the fact that the unsuspecting buyer had paid 98 cents per pound for a cheap tea that was not worth a cent more than 30. The same order included thirty pounds of soda at about the same price that it would sell for at the local grocery store, but there was enough of it to last for four or five years. The same bill of goods which the peddler asked \$41 for could have been bought on tick at the local grocery for \$32, and for \$27.50 if cash had been paid, as it was to the peddler. The experience which these buyers had would seem to suggest the wisdom of at least giving the home merchant an opportunity to bid on a bill of goods before it is given to the representative of the foreign house.
