The Exstern Oregon Insane Asylum bill carries an appropriation of \$200,000, which sum incember 31, 1912. Within 60 days after the act becomes a law, the Governor, Secretary of State, and State Treasurer will select a site for the institution within five miles of Baker, Union or Pendleton. After selecting the site they will have plans drawn for buildings capable of accommodating not less than 600 patients, and will cause the same to be erected.
