Do You Want to Get Into Forest Service

The United States Civil Service Commission announces an examination for assistant forest ranger to be held at Prineville October 21 and 22.

Candidates must be able bodied men between the ages of 21 and 40, capable of enduring all the hardships of outdoor life. A medical certificate to this effect is required. The examination consists of two parts, a field test and the answering of practical questions. The latter relate to land surveying, timber estimating, lumbering, land laws, mining and the livestock business. Practical experience and general intelligence, as shown by ability to write with reasonable clearness of expression, are the main requirements.
