This advertised list of delinquent taxes for the year 1912 is in pursuance of an act of the State Legislature...

The taxes on the following described real property became delinquent on April 7, 1913, and are subject to a penalty of ten per cent and interest at the rate of twelve per cent per annum...

After the expiration of six months from the date of delinquency, and after the publication of the delinquent list, the sheriff is authorized, upon demand of any person, to issue to them a "Certificate of Delinquency" upon payment of taxes, penalty, interest and cost of advertising...

Therefore, on and after the 7th day of October, 1913, I will sell to whoever shall demand, a "Delinquent Certificate" on the following described real estate:
