H. Parry, of Seattle, Wash., and Geo-Rublee, of Cornish, N. H. Politically the commission has three lemocrats, one progressive republican

Davies is commissioner of the bureau of corporations, which is merged with the commission under the new law. ### AMERICAN VESSEL SUNK IN NORTH SEA

Washington. - The United States government was advised officially of the first instance of the destruction of an American vessel on the high seas since the outbreak of the European war. American Consul Fee, at Bremen, cabled that the steamer Evelyn and her cargo of cotton, bound for Bromen, had been "blown up at Borkum" just off the coast of Germany, but that the crew had been saved.




