

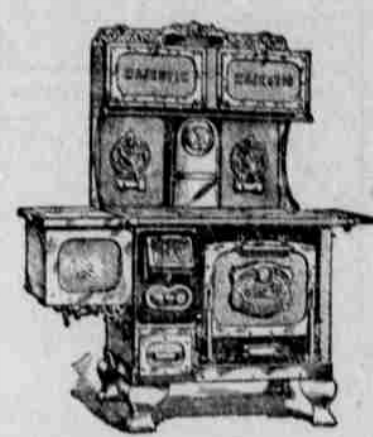
THE CITY

 Chas. Houston's residence a short distance south of Roberts was struck by lightning during an electric storm recently, and would have probably been consumed by fire had it not been discovered at once.

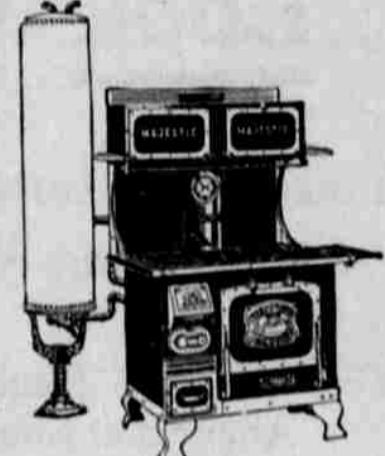

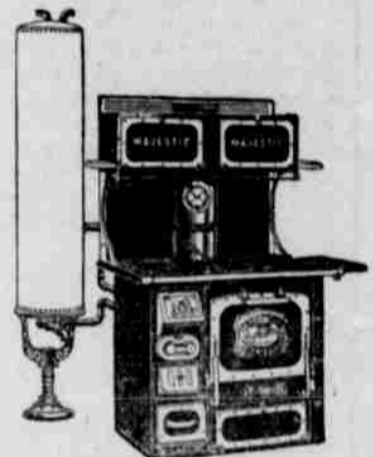

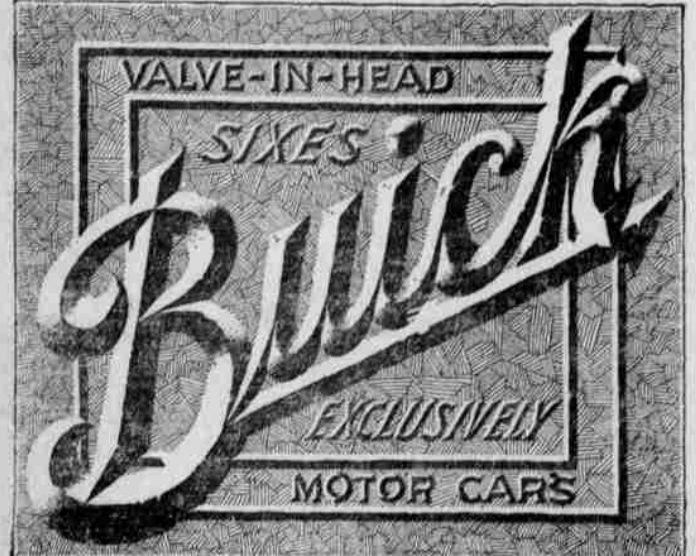
