The Russian armies are continuing their retreat under the persistent pressure of the Austro-Germans. The report from German army headquarters told of the capture of Bielsk on the Brest-Litovsk-Bialystok line, by General von Gallwitz' troops, and the driving of the Russians south of Bielsk over the Biala River. The Russians made a stand before the advance of the army of Prince Leopold of Bavaria, but broke under the German attack and continued their retreat, Berlin announces.

Mayor Rolph of San Francisco has announced himself as a candidate for re-election.

The 45th birthday of Emperor Francis Joseph was celebrated last week in Vienna and Berlin.

The National Education association, in session at Oakland, Cal., elected David B. Johnson, of South Carolina, as its president.

Controller of the Currency Williams has announced that the condition of national banks and reserve banks is such that they will be able to finance the crops and justify an expansion of credit to two or three billion dollars.

Eleven persons are known to have perished in the flood that swept parts of St. Louis and some of the suburbs, and two persons are missing.

Dr. Paul Ehrlich, the German physician, discoverer of salvarsan and of the antitoxin for diphtheria, died suddenly of heart disease at Bad Homburg, Germany, at the age of 61 years.

Miss Grace C. Strachan, district superintendent of schools of Brooklyn, N. Y., has resigned from the National Education association, following her defeat for the presidency of the organization.

BRIEF WAR NEWS

Germany and England have both placed orders for munitions with Swiss factories.

The British reinforced their Gallipoli army during the past week and made slight advance inland from Sulva bay.

Italian troops captured an important Austrian redoubt near Monte Maglio in the Trentino region, General Cadorna reported.

Cotton was officially declared absolute contraband of war by the British government.

BRIEF WAR NEWS

The western front was comparatively quiet during the past week. There has been little fighting except with the heavy guns.

A short official account of the recent fighting on the Gallipoli peninsula indicates that the engagements have been of a rather minor nature, but have favored the allies.

A dispatch from the Austrian headquarters says the offensive of the Austro-German armies in south Poland is proceeding with machine-like regularity and that, although the Russians are clinging desperately to their positions they are being driven back and are now upon their last main line of defense south of the Cholm-Lublin-Ivangorod railroad.
