Know all men by these presents that we, the undersigned residents and freeholders within the State of Oregon and County of Crook, respectfully petition the Honorable County Court of Crook County, Oregon as herein after set forth and each signer hereto for himself declares that he is the holder of title to lands susceptible of irrigation from the sources herein after described lands situated within the boundaries of said proposed district as herein after more particularly set forth and described.
