With the opening of more than half the former saloons at Baker as temperance resorts, Baker has gained the name of the "sandwich city" among hoboes. They assert that there are more sandwiches for sale in Baker than in any city its size in Oregon or Idaho.

A petition of McNary & McNary, counsel for Governor Withycombe and State Treasurer Kay, of the state highway commission, for a rehearing in the state highway engineer case in which it was recently declared that Lewis was highway engineer, has been filed in the supreme court.

State Treasurer Kay has gone to Minneapolis to look after some business matters and, before his return, plans to visit the Minnesota prison at Stillwater and the state capitol at St. Paul with a view of learning something about the state's manufacturing plants and other matters.

The proposed bonding of Wasco county for the building of its section of the Columbia river highway and the improvement of trunk line roads is again being discussed. It is now estimated that the highway can be built up over the hill from Mosier to The Dalles for about \$100,000.

The state of Oregon during the five years ending with 1915 has sent 1226 men to the penitentiary to pay the penalty for crimes ranging from murder in the first degree to simple larceny, and in the same period 1210 pardons, conditional pardons and paroles have been issued to these men.

Delegates from Oregon, Washington, Idaho and Montana, elected to the general conference of the Methodist church, which will convene at Saratoga, N. Y., next May, held a special conference at Portland Tuesday to discuss measures pertaining to the conferences of the northwestern district, which will come before the general conference.

The State Dairymen's association in convention at Oregon agricultural college, following assertions by J. D. Mickle, of Portland, state dairy and food commissioner, to the effect that large city creameries formed combinations detrimental to the success of the small operators and farmers, planned an organization of the co-operative creameries for the protection of the dairymen.
