A Costly Waterloo Medal. Mr. Steward has included in "War Medals and Their History" a special account of the famous Waterloo medal of Pistruct, which originated from the desire of George IV. in 1816 to commemorate the victory by the issue of a specially fine medal. Pistruct designed it, but Pistruct, the chief engraver at the royal mint, refused to cut the dies and was himself commissioned to prepare a modeled design, which, being approved, he was instructed to cut the dies for a fee of £3,500. The dies were not finished until 1819, and of the men who were to receive the medal in gold the Duke of Wellington was the only survivor when the first impression was taken.

ORDINANCE NO. 233

An ordinance providing for the laying and constructing of cement sidewalks and crosswalks on both sides of "Second" street, between "A" street and east bank of the old bed of Crooked River in Prineville, Oregon, and designating the manner of paying for same.

The People of the city of Prineville, Oregon, do ordain as follows: That after the passage of this ordinance, a cement sidewalk and curb be laid on both sides of Second Street, between the curb line on Main Street and the East bank of the old Crooked River bed, in Prineville, Oregon, and that the costs and expenses of the building and the laying of such walk and curb be charged against and made a lien upon all lots, parcels of land and adjoining real estate, directly benefited thereby. For the full cost of building and laying the same, and that the said costs shall be collected in the same manner as costs are collected in making street improvements; Provided, however, that the property owners affected by this ordinance shall be allowed thirty days after the approval of this ordinance to elect whether they will build their respective portions of said walk or not, and in all cases where no notification of election to build shall be filed by said property owners in writing with the Recorder within said thirty days, the City shall proceed at once to build said walks and charge costs of same to the property owners affected as above outlined.

SECTION TWO: That the said sidewalks shall be connected with proper crosswalks to be built by the City, and costs of building and laying of same to be paid out of the general funds of the City.

SECTION THREE: That the said sidewalks and crosswalks whether built by the City or the property owners shall be laid and constructed in accordance with the City ordinance or ordinances and in accordance with the specifications adopted by the City Council, and on file with the City Recorder of the City of Prineville, Oregon.
