A Costly Waterloo Medal. Mr. Steward bas included in "War Medals and Their History" a special account of the famous Waterloo medal of Pistrucci, which originated from the desire of George IV. in 1819 to commemorate the victory by the issue of a specially fine medal. Flayman designed it, but Pistrucci, the chief engraver at the royal mint, refused to cut the dies and was himself commissioned to prepare a modeled design, which, being approved, be was instructed to cut the dies for a fee of £3,500. The dies were not finished until 1849, and of the men who were to receive the medal in gold the Duke of Wellington was the only survivor when the first impression was taken.
