PROCEEDINGS OF THE CROOK COUNTY COURT

Be it remembered a Regular Term of the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Crook was begun and held on Wednesday the first day of November, 1916, the same being the first Wednesday in said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court, when were present at the hour of ten o'clock in the morning the following officers: G. Springer, Judge, presiding; J. F. Blanchard, Commissioner; H. J. Overturf, Commissioner; Warren Brown, Clerk; E. B. Knox, Sheriff. Whereupon, the following proceedings were had to-wit: Whereas, the First National Bank of Bend has turned over warrants Nos. 208, 209, 210, 211 and 212, Class 29, without interest charges on receiving payment of face of same from State, order said warrants cancelled; each of said warrants being in the sum of \$1000. Petition of Sherman Montgomery for cancellation of taxes at Imperial, Oregon, denied. District Attorney instructed to renew Complaints to Public Service Commission for the improvement of telephone connections and rates in Crook County, as no action has been taken by telephone companies operating in said county to remedy said connections since the withdrawal of the complaint on the part of the county on June 6th, 1916. The present complaint shall cover all connections and rates enforced by telephone companies now operating out of Prineville, Redmond and Bend. Court adjourned for day. Convened at regular time November 2nd, all officers present. Report of Crandall and Roberts, Public Accountants, filed August 7th, 1916, hereby approved. In accordance with said report and to correct errors shown therein to exist, order County Treasurer to transfer special funds shown therein to be in error and to collect amounts as shown to be due and owing Crook County; order warrants drawn in favor of R. H. Bayley in the sum of \$27.85 and to Ralph Jordan in the sum of \$9.00. On said report further ordered that General Fund Warrants be issued to Redmond Bank of Commerce in amount equal to cancelled Road warrants, Class B, Nos. 853, 854 and 857, total face value of \$1250, with interest thereon from date of registration; also General Fund Warrants to W. H. May in amount equal to face of cancelled Road Warrants, Nos. 864, 877, 878, 882 and 885, Class B, with interest thereon from date of registration total face value of same being \$1200; further order warrant to W. H. May in the sum of \$7.44 for error, check placed to personal account of W. H. May for which county received benefit. Report of County Clerk on bounties paid by County for September and October, 1916, approved and ordered filed. Viewer's report on Guy E. Dobson road read for the first time. Franchise granted to United States Forest Service for Right of Way on Ochoco County Road for telephone line. Order cancellation of taxes, penalty and interest against Pioneer Telephone and Telegraph Company in total sum of \$172.69. Court adjourned for day and met on third day of November, 1916, at hour of ten o'clock in the morning, Judge Springer, absent. On approval of the following claims by the Sheriff, claims as follows for rebates on taxes allowed: Emma Stuecki, error on assessment roll \$20.00; Oregon & Western Colonization Company, double assessment \$8.30; Ida C. Young Government land, not patented, \$42.57; F. G. Powers Government land not patented \$22.85. Clerk instructed to draw warrants as shown above. Order warrants to J. F. Blanchard and H. J. Overturf each in the sum of \$1000 for road work. Court adjourned this third day of November, 1916, to meet in Regular Adjourned session on Thursday the ninth day of November, 1916, at the hour of ten o'clock in the morning.

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
