SAVE THE CHILD

The Oregon legislature has done a lot of good work this session as compared to the record of the past few years, and the program of economy which they are following is badly needed in the state.

There is one law however which they plan to write onto the books that we think should be left off.

There has been an appropriation for the past several terms of \$5000 each biennium, for the maintenance of a board to enforce the child labor laws. There are four or five members, all competent ladies but one, he being a mere man, and all working without pay but one executive officer.

The plan is to abolish this board, and save the \$2500 per year by throwing the work onto some other state board.

We advise interested persons to write to their representatives and senators and advise them to vote against this bill.

One of the most valuable institutions in the state is the agricultural college. It is to be hoped that in their attempt to economize, the legislature will not limit appropriations and hamper the work of the O. A. C.

The arrest of Mayor H. Gill of Seattle is perhaps another chapter in the story of a crook who tried to come back, and could not.

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The spectacle of some of our legislators voting and clamoring for the passage of the "Bone Dry Bill" is amusing, when the personal habits of these same men are so well known. It is a wonderful demonstration of the power of the will of the people, when it is plainly stated.
