To the Honorable County Court of Crook County, Oregon:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the undersigned residents and freeholders within the State of Oregon and County of Crook, respectfully petition the Honorable County Court of Crook County, Oregon, as hereinafter set forth and each signer hereto, for himself declares and says:

That I am the holder of title to lands susceptible to irrigation from the source hereinafter described, situated within the boundaries of said proposed District, as hereinafter more particularly set forth and described.

That we the undersigned and petitioner hereto propose the organization of an Irrigation District and said signers and petitioners hereby declare that it is the purpose of the petitioners to organize said Irrigation District under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 587 of the General Laws of Oregon for 1917, and any other acts and parts of acts amendatory thereof, and in conformity with the provisions of the law providing therefor, petition this Court for the purposes in this petition stated and given.

The proposed boundaries of said Irrigation District are set forth and described particularly as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section four (4), Township four (4) South, Range fourteen (14) East of the Willamette Meridian and running thence South one mile to the Southeast corner of said Section four (4); thence West one quarter of a mile to the Southwest corner of said Section eight (8); thence South one quarter of a mile to the Northwest corner of said Section nine (9); thence West one quarter of a mile to the Southwest corner of said Section nine (9); thence North one quarter of a mile to the Northwest corner of said Section eight (8); thence East one quarter of a mile to the Southwest corner of said Section eight (8); thence North one half mile to the Northwest corner of said Section five (5); said Township and Range; thence North one quarter of a mile to the Northwest corner of said Section seven (7); thence East one quarter of a mile to the Southwest corner of said Section seven (7); thence North one quarter of a mile to the Northwest corner of said Section eight (8); said Township and Range; thence East one quarter of a mile to the Southwest corner of said Section five (5); said Township and Range; thence North one half mile to the Northwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section five (5);

The signers of this Petition constitute a majority of the holders of title to lands susceptible of irrigation from the source herein described, within the boundaries of said proposed Irrigation District, and said signers hereby petition the Court that three Directors be elected as Directors of said Irrigation District, and that Directors be elected at large from the entire District.

The proable cost of organization of the aforesaid Irrigation District is the sum of two hundred fifty dollars and the Petitioners hereto accompany this Petition with a good and sufficient Bond in the sum of five hundred dollars, which is double the amount of probable cost of the organization of said Irrigation District.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioners pray that said Irrigation District be organized as provided by law, and particularly as set forth and required by the Statutes hereinbefore referred to; that said Petition be heard as required by law and that said County Court shall do any and all things necessary and requisite to effect the organization, and for such other and further order, action and relief as may be necessary and provided by law for the organization of said Irrigation District, your Petitioners will ever pray.

Reference is hereby made to the Notice accompanying this petition, stating the time of the meeting at which this petition will be presented to the said County Court, which said Notice is made a part of this petition.
