CROOK COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS - BILLS ALLOWED

At an adjourned term of the County Court, when were present N. G. Wallace, Judge, H. J. Lister, commissioner, Asa W. Battles, clerk and John Combs, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

Morris Bros. Inc.—In matter of withdrawing of proposal to purchase County bonds

Ordered that Morris Bros. Inc. be allowed to withdraw their offer to purchase bonds of the next road bond issue of Crook County, owing to a decisive decline in the money and bond market, and as Crook County does not now have any bonds for immediate sale.

Agricultural Department—Supplemental agreement Ochoco Canyon road.

Agreement signed June 2nd, and returned for signature of Secretary. Cancellation of warrants over seven years old.

Clerk instructed to have warrants advertised in the official county newspaper stating that if same are not called for within sixty days after July 1, 1920, same will be cancelled.
