Method to Imitate Ground Glass.
To make a varnish to imitate ground glass dissolve 90 grains of sand and 20 grains of mastic in two ounces of methylated ether, and add, in small quantities, sufficient benzine to make it with a suitable grain, too thick making the varnish too transparent and an excess making it crapy. The quantity of benzine required depends upon the quality, from one-half to one and one-half ounces, or even more. The best results are obtained in a medium quality. It is important to use pure washed ether, free from spirit.
