Preach the gospel of St. Johns.

According to notice published elsewhere in this issue a vote will be taken April 5th upon taking into St. Johns a large amount of additional territory. The proposition was rejected last year, but it now seems that a change of heart has occurred, and the outside people are anxious to be gathered into the fold. They want streets laid out and improved and water and light extended to their territory, and in order to have these improvements it is imperative that they join forces with us if the project is carried through this time it will mean about \$1,500,000 additional taxable property added to St. Johns.

We have several times been charged with favoring the purchase of the present ferry system for a consideration. This is entirely erroneous. No offer or overture has been made to us by any one in any manner whatever. Our advertising space is for sale, but our convictions certainly are not. It is entirely immaterial to us whether the city buys the present boat or constructs a new one, only we believe in fair play and believe these gentlemen are entitled to receive fair compensation for their franchise and utilities. Had they known a free ferry would be installed in a couple of years it is unlikely that they would have gone to the expense they did unless they expected to unload upon the city at an exorbitant figure. In that case they would surely have secured a franchise to cover the entire water front instead of the small territory they did secure. The city was so anxious to secure good service across the river at the time the present ferry was installed that there is but little doubt but that this would have been granted.

TRIO OF BAD EGGS.

BUSY CLUB MEETING.

At the regular meeting of the Commercial club last evening a petition was drawn up praying the trolley company to double track their lines outside of the loop. Messrs. Collier, Moxon and Gillmore were appointed to solicit for signatures.

A petition for a phone at the St. Johns depot was ordered prepared and will be circulated for signers. The Ferry company asked the endorsement of the club in the municipal purchase of their apparatus for \$14,000. It was decided that the best plan would be to have three practical men appointed to assess the property—one by the ferry company, one by council and the third agreed upon by both parties.

The club voted to have its president visit the public schools and interest the scholars in sending out literature descriptive of Oregon in general and St. Johns in particular, the club to pay postage thereon.

Steps were discussed to adopt some method of representing St. Johns at the Rose Carnival, and some missionary work was advised regarding the enlargement of the city boundaries.

Seven new members were added to the club.

ADJOURNED MEETING.

Council met in adjourned meeting last evening with all present but Alderman Miller. A communication was read from the Portland General Electric Co. asking for information concerning any franchise the company might have covering Fossenden street. Upon investigation it was discovered that the city of St. Johns had never given the company any franchise.

A proposition was read from the St. Johns Transportation Co. offering to sell their franchise, utilities and appliances to the city for \$14,000. The proposition seemed quite reasonable and the communication was accepted and the city attorney instructed to prepare an ordinance bringing the matter before the people to be voted upon at the April election.

Resolutions to alter Charleston street and condemn certain strips of land thereon were adopted.

Ordinances providing for the improvement of Stafford and Allegheny streets passed the council.

Bills to the amount of \$20.27 for work at the rock crusher were allowed.

IMMENSE CONCRETE FLOOR.

Contract has been let by the Portland Union Stockyards Company for what will probably be the biggest single concrete floor in the world. It will also be the first of its kind ever built, superseding the usual brick and plank flooring used in the large stockyards in packing house centers of the country. When completed, this concrete floor, five inches in thickness will cover 40 acres on the Peninsula, but the contract which was signed up with the Northwest Bridge Company, Saturday will cover about half that area. This, it is figured, will be sufficient to take care of the immediate needs of the new packingtown district, which will be in operation some time the latter part of May or the first of June. The contract runs into the hundreds of thousands of dollars, the exact amount not being divulged by the officials of the stockyard company or the contractors.

In addition to reorganization and incorporation, with increased capital, the Portland Union Stockyards Company have signed up a contract for \$35,000 for a new exchange building, the first of its kind on the coast. This handsome structure, built in colonial style, will be in the form of a hollow square: it will be one story and a half high, with arrangements so that another full story can be added when needed. The exchange building, which will be centrally located in the Packingtown district, will be 110x70 feet and will house the offices for the various commission men who will operate in connection with the plant. The building will have a barber shop, library and reading rooms with restaurant and luncheon, and must be completed by the contractor and turned over to the stockyards company within 100 days or by June 1.

ORDINANCE NO. 217.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION, APPOINTING JUDGES AND CLERKS THEREFOR, DESIGNATING POLLING PLACES AND DIRECTING PUBLICATION AND POSTING OF NOTICES TO ALTER THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF ST. JOHNS AND INCLUDING NEW TERRITORY THEREIN.

The City of St. Johns does ordain as follows:

That whereas on the 23rd day of February, 1909, there was filed in the office of the recorder of the city of St. Johns, Oregon, petitions signed by more than one fifth of the qualified electors of said city of St. Johns, a municipal corporation, incorporated and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Oregon, as shown by the vote cast at the last municipal election held therein, requesting that the Mayor and Council of the City of St. Johns, institute proceedings and call a special election, as provided for by Chapter One of Title Twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes of Oregon, the General Laws of the State of Oregon, and the charter of the said city of St. Johns, to alter the boundaries of the municipal corporation of the said city of St. Johns, and include new territory therein, and submit the question to the electors of said municipal corporation and to the electors residing in the territory proposed to be annexed to such corporation, and to alter a part thereof, which said alteration of said boundaries and new territory to be included is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section One, Township One North, Range One, West of the Willamette Meridian, thence East to the Center line of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Co.'s, right of way to the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Co.'s, right of way to the center of the Oregon Slough; thence at right angles eighty feet to the West side line of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Co.'s, right of way; thence Southwesterly along the West line of the Spokane, Portland & Seattle Railway Co.'s, right of way to a point in the line, hereinafter, through the center of Columbia Slough, if extended; thence Easterly along the line through the center of Columbia Slough extended to the Northeast corner of the Four and one half acre tract of land owned by the Spokane, Portland and Seattle Railway Company; thence Southeastwesterly along said line to the most Easterly corner thereof; thence Southwesterly along the Easterly line of said tract to a point in the North boundary of the County Road known as the Columbia Slough Road; thence Westerly along the present Portland City boundary parallel with, and one hundred and fifty feet Northwesterly from, the North line of said County Road to a point which is intersected by a Northeastwesterly extension in a straight course of the Westerly line of "Ida" street, as located on the map of Northern Hill Acres; thence Southwesterly along said extension, and Westerly side line of said Ida street, and an extension thereof, to the center of the main channel of the Willamette river; thence Northwesterly following the center of the main channel of said river to a point which is intersected by a Westerly extension in a straight course of the North boundary line of Township One, North, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian; thence East along said extension, and said line, to the West line of O. R. & N. R. R. right of way; thence Easterly along the Northwestwesterly line of said right of way to a point which is intersected by the North boundary of Township One, North, Range One West, on the North line of the Northeast quarter of Section One, thence East to the place of beginning.

And whereas it appears that said petition is in all things regular and in accordance with the laws in such cases made and provided, and, whereas it further appears that such alterations of the boundaries of the municipal corporation of the said City of St. Johns, and including of the new territory therein, as petitioned, is for the best interests of all concerned, now therefore, the city of St. Johns does ordain as follows:

That a special election be, and the same is hereby ordered to be held on the 5th day of April, 1909, between the hours of Nine o'clock in the forenoon and Seven o'clock in the afternoon of said day, at which said special election there shall be submitted to the electors of the said city of St. Johns, and to the electors residing in the territory proposed by the aforesaid petition to be annexed to said corporation, the said city of St. Johns, and become a part thereof, the said proposition, of altering the boundaries of the municipal corporation of the said city of St. Johns, and including new territory therein, as prayed for in the aforesaid petition, and as herein described and set forth. And notice of such special election shall be given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the said city of St. Johns, and in such territory so proposed to be annexed (if a paper is published therein) for a period of four (4) weeks prior to such election. And notice thereof shall be posted in four (4) public places within the said city of St. Johns, and in four (4) public places in such territory so proposed to be annexed for a like period before such election. Such notice shall distinctly state the proposition to be submitted, and shall designate specifically the boundaries of the territory so proposed to be annexed, and the electors shall be invited to vote upon such proposition by placing upon their ballots the words "For annexation" or "Against annexation" or words equivalent thereto.

The polls for such election shall be open for the First ward of said city of St. Johns at 209 West Burlington street. For the second ward of said city of St. Johns at the City Hall. For the territory so proposed to be annexed at North School in Holbrook Addition, Block 21, and Holbrook Building at Smith's Crossing.
