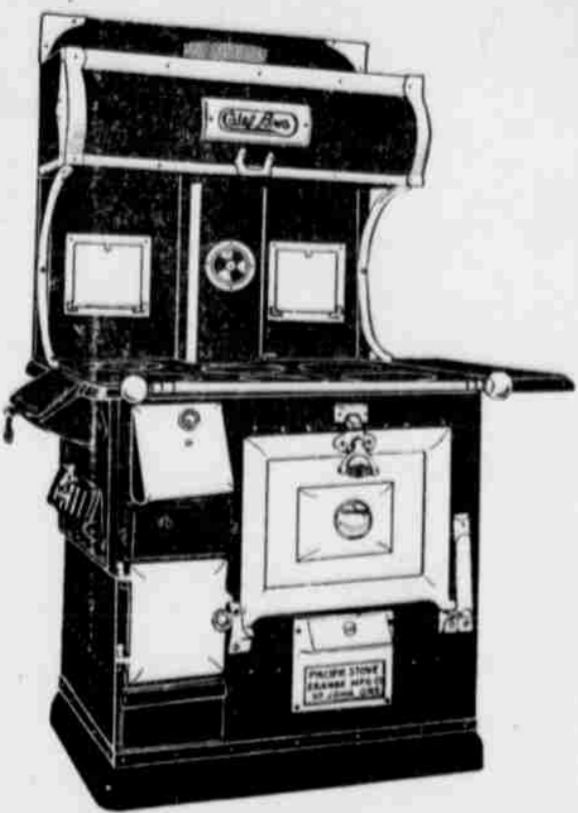

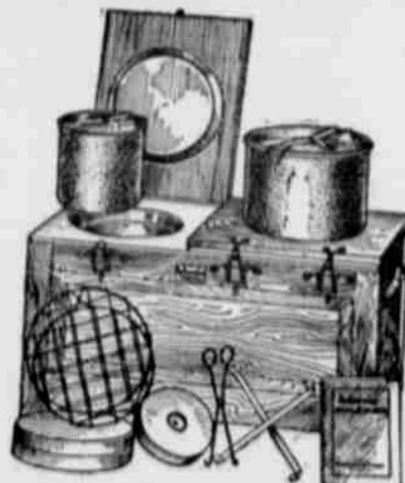

WORTH KNOWING

Destroying Ants---

To kill ants and keep them out of the house and away from lawns, plants, etc., the following methods are effective:

For the House or Fountain: Moisten a sponge with a weak solution of syrup. Place this where the ants congregate. They will become entangled in it, when the sponge may be put in hot water, cleaned of dead ants and the "trap" set again.

Another remedy is powdered borax, which should be sprinkled on the shelves, etc., and also into crevices, corners and openings. Balsam of Peru is also an efficient exterminator, as is camphor, sulphur, alum, oil of cedar and tartar emetic.
