Said improvements to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the city of St. Johns, and under the supervisio and direction of the city engineer.

That the cost of said improvement to be assessed on a pro-rata basis as provided by city charter upon the property especially and particularly benefitted thereby, and which is hereby declared to be all of lots parts of lots, blocks and parcels of land between the termini of such improvements abutting upon, adjacent or proximate to said street from the marginal lines of said street back to the center of the block or blocks or tracts of land abutting thereon or proximate

That all the property included in said improvement district aforesaid is hereby declared to be Local Improvement

That the city engineer's assessment of the probable total cost of said improve ment of said street is \$5,658,80.

That the cost of said street be assessed

on a pro rata basis against the property it district as pr vided by the charter of the city of St. O. J. GATZMYER Adopted by the council this 29th day of




