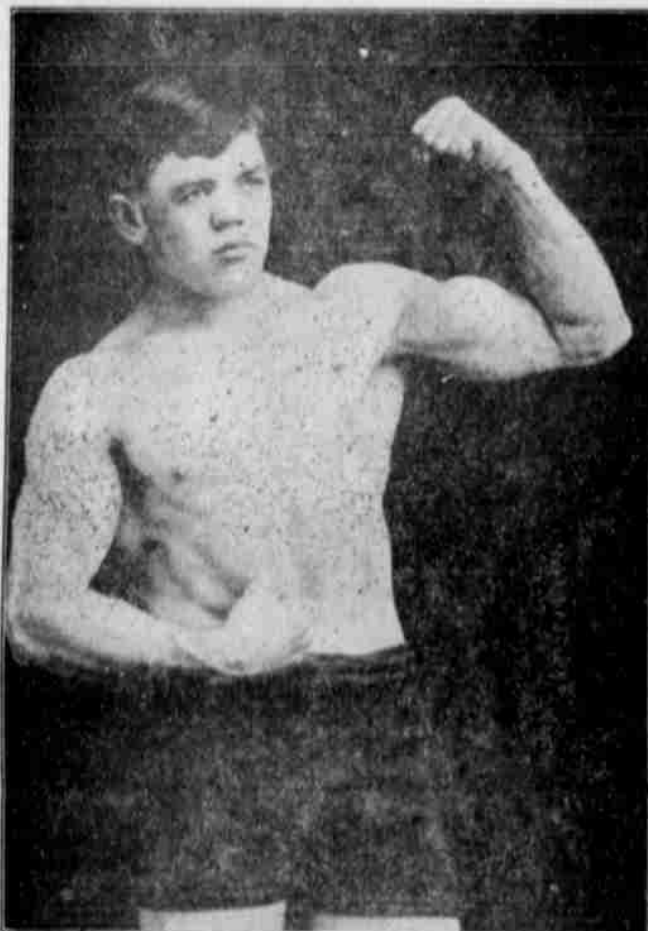
Sensational High Wire Bicycles, America's Foremost Aeronauts

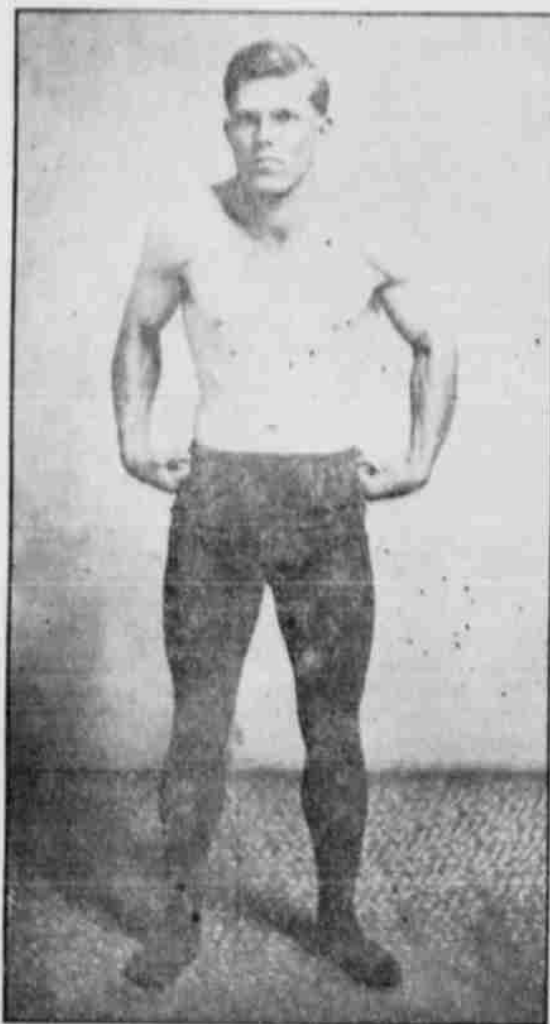

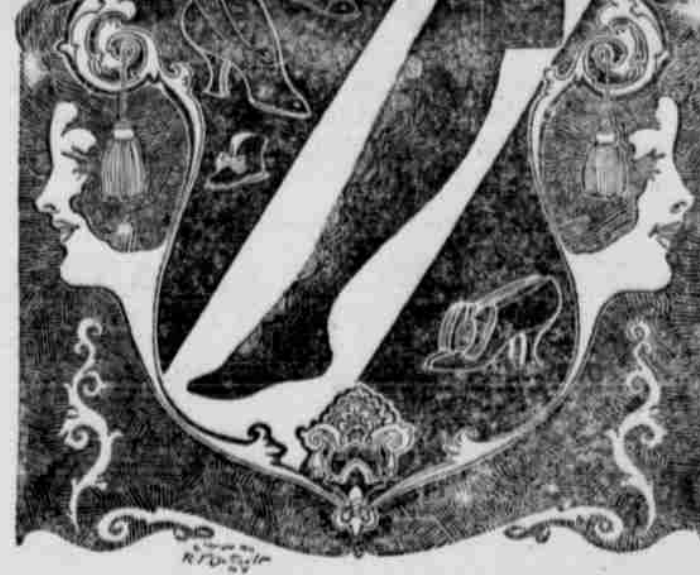
