The Portland Journal scored a point over the Evening News the past week. For several days the News had been boasting and flatteringly telling its readers what a wonderfully low bid it was going to make on publishing the delinquent tax list in order to save the unfortunate ones a pot of money. When the bids were opened, it was found that the Journal bid was 30 cents per inch, while the boasted News bid was 40c per inch. Were the Review eligible to bid, it would gladly have taken the contract at 25 cents per inch. Concerning the "graft saving" bid of the News announced Tuesday evening the News announced that it would bid and bid so low that "this delinquent tax graft" would be made "so microscopic that it won't be worth the candle." The tender of the News is not consistent with its utterance. The 1918 rate card shows that this paper makes a minimum rate of 34 cents an inch to large commercial advertisers on long contracts. According to the same rate card, an advertiser using one-third as much space as will be occupied by the delinquent tax list would pay the same rate, 40 cents a column inch, that the News will charge the county.
