so. If they are to make it so, then the job is largely up to the teachers we employ in our schools.

The conception of what a school ought to be has been magnified a hundredfold in the last quarter of a century. City life, relieving the child of disciplinary farm chores and also largely depriving him of his father's attention because of the stress and strain of wage earning, has shifted more and more of the responsibility for young America upon the shoulders of the teacher. The birch rod teacher of the little red school house, the utmost flight of whose imaginings was confined by the "three R's" has given place to the teacher who trains first for citizenship, for producing, for humanity, the "three R's" serving only as a means to the end. To cope ably with illiteracy we must begin with the teacher who, herself, must be able and well educated, that she may tackle the big problem which is staring America in the face. We are all filled with good intentions towards the teacher, but it too often stops there. The annual average salary in the United States for all teachers has been put at \$630.-34. This includes all the rural teachers, of course. Communities differ in respect to their degree of failure to give the teachers a square deal. The 2 mill elementary school levy intends to take care of the children in Portland and Oregon and if the measure fails to pass many of our elementary schools must be closed.—Contributed.
