At an interesting meeting of the St. Johns Community Club held at the Y. W. C. A. building Tuesday evening, T. J. Monahan was unanimously re-elected president, H. W. Bonham re-elected vice president, Mrs. Bertha Montgomery re-elected secretary and Sergt. Crane made treasurer, all by unanimous vote. A. W. Markle was again made publicity man. Pleading selections were rendered by the Choral Club, led by Mrs. S. A. Mulkey. Attorney J. O. Bailey of the committee of protest against proposed increase in rates of gas, telephone and trolley interests reported that the gas company had had a hearing and the telephone case now in progress, and he gave information relative to the proposed new rates.

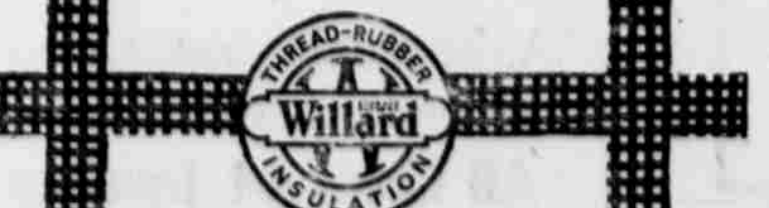
