With a crew of 225 men the Peninsula Lumber company's plant began operations, Monday, after being closed for alterations and repairs since early in December. The mill has a daily capacity of more than 200,000 feet. Continued operation of the mill is contingent upon the improvement in the lumber market and reduction in transcontinental freight rates on lumber, it is said.

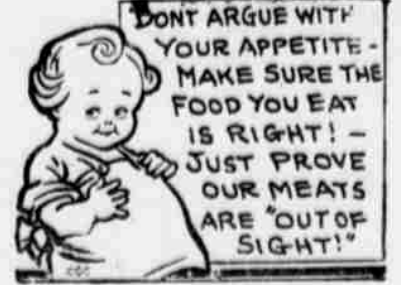
